(2) Part-time Mandarin: 3 NCCU credits. *Home university has the right to decide if the credits could be transferred. *Students of Mainland China, Hong Kong, Macau, and Taiwan nationality will not be able to enroll in Mandarin language courses.	
Credits Recommended to Take	9-18 NCCU credits (maximum 25 NCCU credits for undergradutes) *Credit Transfer: 1 credit at NCCU = 18 lecture hours = 2 ECTS
