## >> Modalities

The undergraduate and graduate students may apply for academic mobility at Universidad Nacional de Colombia for any of the following activities:

**Study abroad:** Academic activity in which students can take courses or seminars related to the curriculum in our institution.

Internship: This is an academic activity that contributes to the professional and social development of undergraduate students through the experience and application of the knowledge acquired during their professional training.

**Research Stay:** It is an academic activity in which a student develops studies, analyzes or experiments in addition to his/her research practices, in our institution under the supervision of a researcher belonging to our faculty.

Medical Rotation: It is an academic activity in which the students in the health area practice their knowledge and skills in different areas of their interest.

For the modalities of study abroad, internships, research and medical rotation, the guest students must obtain prior approval of a tutor, who will be responsible for their activities at Universidad Nacional de Colombia.

## >>> Procedure for students

To apply as a visiting student at our University, students must follow this process: First, students must register their Incoming Mobility Application at the **Information System** of the National Office of External Affairs (DRE – in Spanish Dirección de Relaciones Exteriores) and upload the following documents online:



Nomination letter by the home university (on university letterhead and stamped).

Official transcript of records.

Copy of passport (foreign students) or copy of Colombian citizenship card (Colombian students).

5 Letter of economic support whereby candidates declare their financial capacity to cover the costs involved in mobility. If candidates receive a scholarship, they must enclose a certificate stating they are scholarship holders.

In the case research or internship, students must
submit a letter of invitation from a Professor
(tutor) of our University. The letter of invitation
corresponds is a document whereby a Professor
from the Universidad Nacional de Colombia ideally from the same research field and topic officially declares his/her willingness to be the
student's mentor during his/her academic stay.
We therefore suggest that students directly
contact one of the professors in their Faculty of
interest.
