Requirements	 The qualified international students are invited to apply for TU exchange program by being nominated through partner universities. The eligibility requirements are 1. Enrolled as a degree student in home university 2. Have completed at least one academic year of study in home university 3. Nominated by home university an official coordinator s email address from a home university is required 4. Have good academic standing with GPA not less than 3 0 out of 4 scale or equivalent. If lower, please discuss with OIA 5. Command good English proficiency. It is important to know that each faculty program has different criteria of TOEFL and IELTS, please see the attached criteria sheet for more details 6. Exchange students must enroll at least 3 courses equivalent to 9 credits in one discipline at Thammasat university in order to be recognized as the major and must remain in these three courses throughout their study period at Thammasat university. The maximum credits exchange students are allowed to enroll are 18 credits counting from credits gained through the major and crossing disciplines

As an international student, you need to have a valid travel documents passport and entry visa to enter Thailand

International passport must be valid for a minimum of 6 months beyond the expected date of exit from the country

A visa must be obtained BEFORE you enter Thailand by self representation at the visa issuing office For Immigration clearance, you are required to produce the Immigration approval letter upon arrival
