Every student at the University of Muenster has to pay a social contribution fee for each semester, approximately 350 Euro. This fee contains the costs for the semester ticket that allows students to travel around the state of North Rhine-Westphalia. The living expenses for students in Münster run approximately 950 Euro per month, including accommodation, food and leisure activities. None
Insurance packages exchange	All exchange students have to have a European health insurance.
students are required to purchase	This is to be finalised upon arriving in Münster. Costs are approximately 110 Euros per month.

Visa requirements	Accepted exchange students will receive a letter of admission for the German embassy. Students coming to Germany will have to apply for a student visa via the Germany embassy in their home countries. The visa process might take up to six weeks . After arrival in Muenster, students from Non-EU countries with a stay longer than 3 months <u>have to apply for a residence permit</u> (costs about 100 €). Detailed information will be sent to all incoming exchange students.
