	 The upper-year courses with pre-requisites are not open to visiting exchange students unless the student obtains approval from Saint Mary's academic advisor of the subject area ahead of time. Our academic advisor uses the student's home university transcript to assess their academic background. The student's academic transcript in English should be sent to Global@smu.ca, and we will ensure that our academic advisors can access a copy. Not all pre-requisite override requests may be approved. Not all times courses students want to choose may be available; thus, we do not recommend our exchange program to students who have a specific set of courses they must complete during the exchange program.
Areas of study NOT available to exchange students	Graduate programs Saint Mary's exchange program is best set up for undergraduate students who are seeking to register in undergraduate-level courses. If your university is considering nominating a graduate candidate, please email <u>Miyuki.arai@smu.ca</u> to discuss the plan before nominating the graduate student. Not all times graduate students will be accepted on the visiting exchange program.

Other requirements	 There is no GPA requirement, but pre-requisite courses for a SMU course need a pass at a grade of 65% or higher at the home institution. Students should have flexibility in their course selection to ensure they can change their preferred courses if needed.
